

Regarding Orange receivers from Hobby King

Since the DSM2 receiver is a “talk back” it requires an FCC approval sticker affixed somewhere on the outside of the case.

The official AMA stance on this issue is that all equipment used is to be FCC certified where required. The responsibility of confirming the equipment is certified is up to the owner/user of that equipment, not the AMA or its representatives. The fact that the mandate of certification is a Federal Law requires the FCC maintain full jurisdiction over the enforcement of that law.

There is an exclusion in the current AMA liability policy for “[...]Bodily injury” or “property damage” arising from the use of equipment that has been ruled obsolete by the FCC.” Since the exclusion does not specifically address non-certified equipment, the policy may respond if a claim was made. However, final decision on coverage and paid damages is determined by a Third Party Administrator based upon the details of the incident and terms and conditions of the appropriate policy.
